AWP INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP*

The AWP is proud to sponsor the Association of Women Psychiatrists International Fellowship. This Fellowship offered yearly is dedicated to enhance AWP's commitment to improve the mental health of women globally. To this end, AWP selects on even number years a fellow within residents in training in the United States. In alternative odd number years, the International Fellow will be recruited among residents in training or early career psychiatrists from countries outside the United States.

US INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP 2018:

The selected individual must be in psychiatry residency training program or within one year of completion of training in the United States. The fellow will receive a total of \$3,000. \$1,500 will be to defray the cost of attending the **APA Annual Meeting in 2018** and an additional \$1,500 to support travel to an international destination where their project would occur to be distributed once planned proposal and travel are approved by AWP. We will be awarding this International Fellowship in New York, May, 2018 at the APA Annual Meeting.

Application requirements:

1. Applicant's CV
2. Two letters of recommendation
3. One to two pages personal statement addressing the goals and requirements of the proposed project
4. One to two pages statement about proposed project and use of fellowship funds

Requirements of the Fellow-in-training in the United States would be:

1. Present a brief description of their project at AWP Annual Meeting and awards presentation
2. Organize or participate in an APA workshop or symposium the following year
3. Help select the International Fellow for the following year
4. Enhance the presence of AWP at their chosen international site
5. Submit one article over the course of the year about her work to AWP newsletter

Application deadline: March 1

Awardee notified: April 1
